Project Haugaland site, 80 Ha, is part of a 500 Ha industrial park, owned by Haugaland Næringspark AS. The site has significant growth opportunities. Haugaland consists of a fairly flat area situated next to a strong substation with 6 MW available in 2019, 35 MW in 2022 and 500MW in 2026. Other infrastructure i.e. dark fibre access, proper

country roads, and international airport, ISPS certified port next to the site are good. The city centre of Haugesund is about 30 minutes away by car. The site is facilitated by Statkraft. The area is located between 25m and 47m above sea level. Water and sanitary are available on site. Industrial zoning regulation and consent is completed.
